Oakfields Montessori Day Nursery is a privately owned nursery, we first opened in 1991 and we are situated in a residential area of Gidea Park. We are open from 8am until 6pm for 48 weeks of the year and close for 2 weeks in the summer, 1 week at Christmas and 1 week at Easter.

Our premises consist of a converted house with an enclosed outdoor play area. We are registered for a maximum of 36 children per day and we operate from 4 classrooms. Owls class, Hedgehogs class, Squirrels class and the Foxes class.

We offer first class care and education to children from the age of 2-5years, combining the highest standards of care with a pre-school curriculum that has the needs of the individual child at its core.
